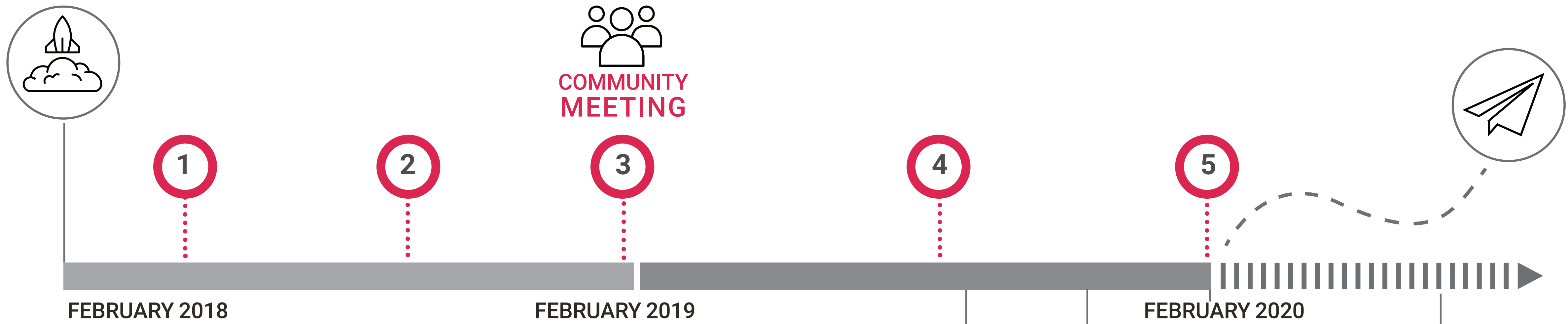

I'd like the future generations to see this community as a safe and loving place.

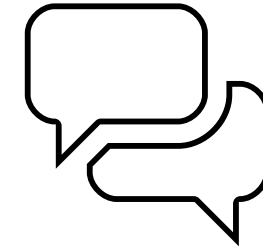
Well taken care of in terms of green spaces, trash/recycle bins, open for youth to explore/play and welcoming for visitors.

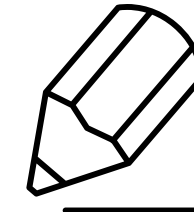

Create an inviting community that is clean, green, and safe with beautiful, active public spaces. Connect people to these places, to nature and recreation, and to one another.



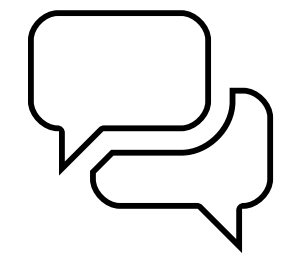


CONNECT

BV survey takers feel their health could be improved by:

- 1 - LOCATING MORE MEDICAL FACILITIES IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD
- 2 - PROVIDING A SHUTTLE TO MEDICAL SERVICES

Top health issues affecting BV survey takers and their families:

- 1 - ASTHMA/BREATHING ISSUES
- 2 - DEPRESSION, ANXIETY & POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS
- 3 - HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE

HOUSING

69% of BV survey takers would like to buy a home

Top 3 types of housing that Neighborhood residents feel are needed:

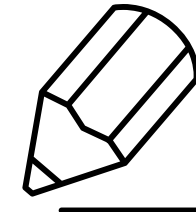
- 1 RENOVATED HOMES FOR HOMEOWNERSHIP
- 2 SENIOR HOUSING
- 3 NEW AFFORDABLE RENTAL HOUSING

HEALTHY FOOD

40% of BV survey takers do not have enough food to eat once or twice a week or more

60% & 68% of BV residents of Neighborhood residents rated the availability of high-quality fresh fruits, vegetables and food as Fair to Very Poor

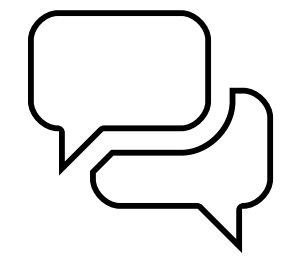

- 3 - LACK OF SKILLS

Programs that would be most helpful for BV residents looking for work:

- #1 **JOB FAIRS**
- #2 **A RENT FREEZE PROGRAM FOR THE FIRST YEAR OF EMPLOYMENT**
- #3 **CONTINUING EDUCATION LEADING TO A JOB-RELATED CERTIFICATE OR DEGREE PROGRAM**

EDUCATION

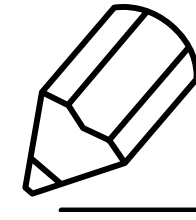
69%

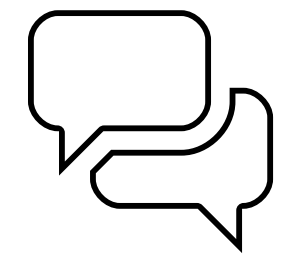

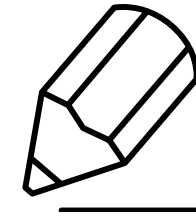
